The UNFCCC enhanced transparency framework demands substantial and immediate progress in the countries' domestic Monitoring Reporting and Verification (MRV) systems and strategic de-carbonization planning. This entails moving from often disintegrated and often different-methodological approaches in data management to an integrated and robust system. The success of the Paris Agreement hinges on enhanced transparency of action and support, as a critical foundation to making its bottom-up, country-led approach work, as well as building mutual trust and confidence amongst Parties. GEF- CBIT will support Sierra Leone in establishing an overarching structure across all sectors that will ensure high quality in its transparency instruments; and create the capacities to respond to UNFCCC's reporting requirements. CBIT's most important contribution will occur by building capacity and setting up systems to collect data and track NDC implementation.

The Local MRV consultant will work closely with the international consultant to develop four technical guidelines for data generation and management in key sectors; develop the NDC implementation Plan, and update the NDC reflecting the MPGs from the COP 24 including gender-sensitive indicators.

#### **Objectives**

The overall objective of the work is to identify and assess the different options and possibility for a domestic MRV and to develop and operationalize a MRV plan

Specific objectives of the work include the following;

- Develop methods and approaches for establishing a national MRV, following good international practices and established techniques.
- Develop a detailed NDC implementation plan to establish/strengthen MRV systems
- Develop technical management guidelines aligned with the 2006 IPCC guidelines for all sectors.
