- 1. The Government of Sierra Leone has received financing from the African Development Fund hereinafter called the Bank toward the cost of the Mano River Union Road Development and Transport Facilitation Programme Phase IV, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Upgrading of Regional Integrated Roads Project in Sierra Leone: Kailahun Koindu Guinea Liberia Border Roads Project Lot II: Buedu Guinea Liberia Border Roads 39Km .For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the Bank's Disbursement Guidelines and procedures for Investment Project Financing."
- 2. The Sierra Leone Roads Authority (SLRA) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Upgrading of Regional Integrated Roads Project in Sierra Leone: Kailahun Koindu Guinea Liberia Border Roads Project Lot II: Buedu Guinea Liberia Border Roads 39Km of which the scope of works comprises of clearing and grubbing, earthworks, pavement works, ancillary works. The work will be carried out in the Eastern Provincial District of Kailahun and is to be carried out for a period of 24 months and a 12-month Defects Liability Period. Environmental Measures, awareness raising and implementation of the Resettlement Action Plan are also to be implemented as part of the project.
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through the Open Competitive Bidding (International), OCBI procedures as specified in the Bank's <u>Procurement Framework</u> [Bank's Procurement Policy dated October 2015] and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Framework.
- 4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the Sierra Leone Roads Authority and inspect the Bidding document during office hours i.e. 09h00 to 17h00 hours at the address given below.

5. The Bidding document in English may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of USD 750.00 (Seven Hundred and Fifty United States Dollars) or its equivalent in Leones. The method of payment will be Direct Deposit to the Employer's Bank Account at the Bank of Sierra Leone through account Buedu – Guin – Lib Boarder Rds 39Km Acc No. 0122001754 or 0122001761. The document will be sent by surface mail/courier or email as the case may be.

Bid opening was scheduled for the 17th July, 2025 for the aforementioned works.
