The consulting services (“the Services”) include “Fiduciary Services to improve financial transparency and accountability of EDSA’s financial operations.” *The estimated level of effort (professional staff-months) for this assignment is Twelve (12) man months, renewable based on satisfactory performance and availability of funds. Implementation is expected to commence on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2026.*
