The Government of Sierra Leone has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Connectivity and Agricultural Market Infrastructure Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for: 1. Construction of two climate-resilient long span bridges and their link roads in Kabba and Komrabai (Lot no. 1); and 2. Construction of two climate-resilient long span Bridges and their link roads in Moselolo and Sumbuya (Lot no. 2). For these contracts, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing.
2. The Ministry of Transport and Aviation now invites sealed Proposals from the following initially selected eligible Applicants for Construction of two climate-resilient long span bridges and their link roads in Kabba and Komrabai (Lot no. 1); and 2. Construction of two climate-resilient long span Bridges and their link roads in Moselolo and Sumbuya (Lot no. 2). **A Proposer that has been initially selected for both lots may submit a proposal for one or both lots, however only one contract (lot) will be awarded per Proposer.**

3. The procurement will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Proposals (RFP) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" March, 2025 and is open to all initially selected eligible Proposers.

A single-stage, two envelope RFP process will be used, and the Proposal will consist of (i) the Technical Part, without any reference to prices; and (ii) the Financial Part, as detailed in the RFP Document. The Technical and Financial Parts of the Proposals shall be submitted simultaneously in two separate sealed envelopes.
6. The Proposal, both the Technical Part and the Financial Part, must be delivered to the address below on or before 29th May, 2026 at 11:00 hrs (local time). Electronic Procurement will not be permitted. Late Proposals will be rejected. The Technical Part of the Proposals will be publicly opened in the presence of the Proposers' designated

representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on 29th May, 2026 at 11:00 hrs (local time). The Financial Part shall remain unopened and will be held in safe custody of the Employer until the second public opening of the Financial Part, following the evaluation of the Technical Part of the Proposals.

7. All Proposals must be accompanied by a Proposal Security of Five Hundred Thousand United States Dollars (USD\$ 500,000.00) or equivalent in freely convertible currency.
8. All Proposals must be accompanied by a Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA) and/or Sexual Harassment (SH) Declaration.
9. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful Proposer's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the RFP document."
